In collaboration with the European Network Europa Nostra "PERREVIA" Network sets up a special Scientific Committee seeking Monuments that are in danger throughout Greece

A pan-European campaign for the preservation and protection of Cultural Heritage



"PERREVIA" Network started a campaign throughout Greece, in order to mobilizing public and private partners at local, national and European level, so as to locate the monuments of special cultural value, that are in danger. The "7 Most Endangered" monument is an innovative project that was launched in January 2013 by Europa Nostra with the European Investment Bank Institute as founding partner and the Council of Europe Development Bank as associated partner. t was inspired by a successful similar project run by the US National Trust for Historic Preservation.

Establishment of a Special Scientific Committee

In order for the "PERREVIA" Network to support a program of high requirements and specialization, such as the "7 Most Endangered" monuments, set up a 3-member scientific committee, consisting of the following recognized researchers:
